"Ten Ways to Love your Brain: Maintaining Brain Care As We Age" was the topic of the morning. Connie Metzler, is Program Coordinator and Nurse Case Manager for the Alzheimer's and Memory Care Program at Lancaster General Health Penn Medicine. She spoke about ways to use our brain to keep it alive and well.

Bob Weaver introduced Connie by sharing of his experience a few years

ago when he attended Memory Care at LGH.

Dementia is a disease of the brain. It is an umbrella term for many



kinds of brain impairments – frontal temporal, vascular, Alzheimer's. The number one risk factor is age. She distributed



a sheet suggesting "10 ways to love your brain." Of course, diet and exercise are part of the program. So are getting enough sleep, staying socially engaged, playing games. There are free apps for brain games such as Wordle, Luminosity and others.

Being aware of warning signs of dementia can point the way to talking to your doctor. Changes more than normal are diagnosed as mild cognitive impairment.

Following a question and answer period, a delicious meal was served.
